In addition to their St. Patrick’s Day residency at Ulysses Pub in NYC, the CBB makes sure to extend the High Holy Season in all directions, performing regularly at The New Jersey State Police Pipes and Drums of the Blue and Gold Annual Pub Night, Flagship Brewery’s Annual Pre-Parade Party, The Rockaway Hotel Post Parade Celebration, The Wicked Wolf’s Parade Day Bash and Bay Ridge St. Patrick’s Day Parade Dinner Dance. Audiences can also see them every summer in East Durham at the East Durham Irish Festival, Gavins’ Irish Country Inn’s Memorial Day Celebration, Gavinstock, and GuinnessFest. The CBB can be seen annually at The Great Irish Fair, Irish Night at the Breezy Point Queens Ballpark, Irish Night in Shore Road Park, Rockaway Beach/Breezy Point Irish Festival and many more.
